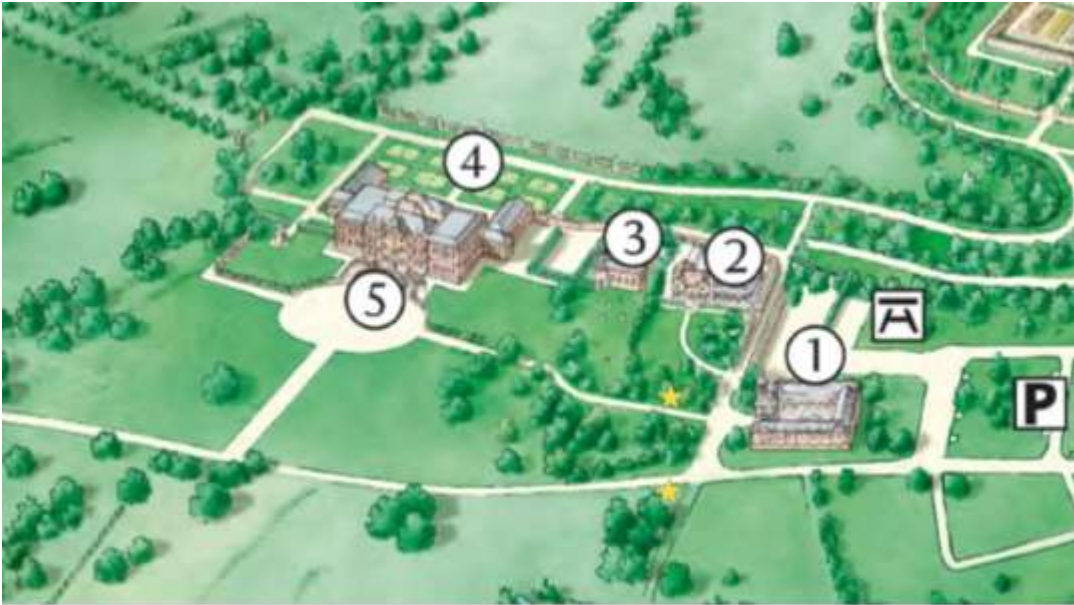


Wimpole Estate Maths Trail

- 5. Wimpole Hall** - What would be a quick and effective way of estimating the number of windows at the front of the hall? Now try it.
- 6. Wimpole Hall** – Can you identify any angles on the building? E.g. acute, right-angle, obtuse...
