Parenting Top Tip

Internet and digital safety, as well as all things techy are a hot topic in the media and in society right now, with lots of parents worrying about keeping their children safe and mentally healthy with gadgets. We don't have to all become experts but by communicating openly with our children and knowing where to turn for up-to-date digital safety advice, we can stay on top of concerns.

- Get curious, not combative ask open ended questions, keep the conversation
- Create a judgement free zone be there to listen, not just lecture.
- Decode together ask them to explain their digital world, don't assume just ask.
- Teach critical thinking help them question online content, not just follow rules.
- Monitor without spying make checking in on their online spaces a normal part of
