#### **Collective Worship**

We continue to work as an extended team across schools and with our local parish to share planning for Collective Worship and support each other in the planning and teaching Biblical values. We have continued to follow the theme of 'courage' linked to the Lent Challenge from last half term.

# **Collective Worship Summer 1 highlights**

In the Summer 1 half term we have focused on the following each week:

- Week 1 We celebrated Easter at Petersfield during Collective Worship including starting the term with a joint service led by Amanda Tuck.
- Week 2 Following on from St George's Day, we reflected on how we can respond to fears and worries. We explored what the Bible says about worries.
- Week 3 We reflected on the story of David and Goliath, thinking how we as individuals and collectively respond to instances of bullying.
- Week 4 We reflected on the story of Daniel who was prepared to stand up for his beliefs.
- Week 5 Through the story of The Selfish Crocodile, children are challenged to be courageous in offering friendship.
- Week 6 We reflect on the Collective Worship theme of courage and explored the link to the GenR8 trust resources.

### **Our Church Community**

We were delighted to invite volunteers from our community who have not attended a big event at Petersfield during Covid.
